**Secretary's Minutes:** Sandy Kaske moved to approve the minutes from the April meeting, and Mike Rogers 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All directors approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** \$77,391.98 overall total. Michel Johannes made a motion to approve the treasurer's report and Alicia Perez 2<sup>nd</sup>. All directors approved.

**A.D. Report:** Karen thanked Denise Hauser and Michelle Dixon for organizing the athletic banquet. Karen had several people comment that they enjoyed the food and the socializing before the awards. Many people liked hearing about sports other than the ones their children were in and Tracy McConnell suggested having one person thank the entire list of people that each coach thanked that night. Another suggestion was to hold this event earlier in the day and on a weekend.

Karen also thanked Michel Johannes and Carla Sullivan and the Doctors who helped give sports physicals at BNHS.

Milt Brown and his wife should be made honorary Lifetime Members of the Blue Thunder Boosters Karen suggested, and all agreed.

Donations for the golf outing are needed by June 20.

Aramark asked what we would be doing for concessions next year. They suggested having one person manage for football and one manage for indoor sports. Karen asked if any of us were health board certified and interested in managing the concessions for next year.

**Membership/Fundraising:** no report

**Merchandise:** \$310 sold at Athletic Award Banquet. Meeting in June with committee to order for fair.

**Marketing/Website:** Kelly is sending flyers/brochures to Michel and she will send to Paul Pecha to post on our Website. The summer hours for the weight room can be posted also. M, W, F 7 am – 10 am

**Old Business: Mobile House of Thunder** –This is ordered. The additional changes were: gas shocks for \$290, two-24 inch doors in back for \$205, a receptacle for \$25, partition with pocket door \$205 for a total of \$725 extra. It should be ready for the fair. We still need year round indoor storage.

**Play Day** – Golf forms have been sent out and some foursomes are set up already. The committee will advertise in the shopper, BDR, RRS and possibly radio. We need flyers at the businesses that are sponsoring this event.

**Gator 4-wheeler** – Scott Hyser said painting this wouldn't hold up well and he suggested ordering replacement parts in the color we want. The directors previously discussed this and agreed to order the parts we need in red for \$900. The original green parts will be sold on ebay. Also, a large "N" decal will be placed on the hood and decals with "Donated by Blue Thunder Boosters and Hammertime" will be placed on both sides near the back. Hammertime donated \$3000 and we donated \$8000 of the \$11,000 total.

**2008 Golf Play Day** –Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at Timber Pointe with a shotgun start at 1:30 pm. Forms are ready to print, Michel has stamps and Dave Gallano will bring a trailer for the band. Golf Shack will sponsor a hole in one. There will be a silent auction and each sports team will be asked to put together a basket for this. Dick Kirchner is working on "Blue Thunder/Bucs Open" golf shirts with company logos for the golfers.

**New Business:** There are 5 two-year director positions open for 2008-09. The one-year director terms for Curt Lindaas, Sandy Kaske, Mike Rogers, Joan Ollmann, and Alicia Perez are up. All five said they were interested in continuing, and Kim Larson and Craig Adams also said they were interested in a director position. Mike Rogers and Curt Lindaas then rescinded their nominations to allow Kim and Craig a chance. Sue Rodakowski made a motion to install Sandy Kaske, Joan Ollmann, Alicia Perez, Craig Adams and Kim Larson as 2-year term directors starting at the June 2008 meeting. Michel Johannes 2<sup>nd</sup>, and all other directors approved.

All committees decided to remain the same as last year, but merchandise asked for new members and Curt Lindaas and Sara Barton agreed to be on this committee. We would like Sandy Christianson to continue to manage concessions for football and Sara Barton may consider helping with indoor concessions. Thunderspud will continue to be chaired by Sandy Kaske and Tracy McConnell will join her.

2008-09 Memberships – Membership committee will discuss another giveaway for new Lifetime members if we can't offer passes to home games next year. At this time all ticket money goes to District 100.

Cross Town Classic/Castle Bank Challenge – This will be held on Saturday, October 11, 2008. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade football games will be played at BCMS in the afternoon followed by the sophomore and Varsity games hopefully in the new BNHS football stadium. We need to move forward with plans as if our new stadium will be ready. Contracts are in place and everything is pre-cut so it should be ready by the final date of October 1, 2008. We will have our Mobile House of Thunder to use for this game and we need someone to become health certified in our club. Also, a committee needs to be established and will need to meet with the Buc Boosters. The members who chose to join this committee are Brad and Michel Johannes, Kim Larson, Bob Moore, Mike Rogers, Michelle Dixon, Denise Hauser, Alicia Perez, Carla Sullivan and Karen Reynolds. Brad will meet with Bill Hatfield and get rules about health certification. The meeting will be held Thursday June 5<sup>th</sup> at 4 o'clock in the BNHS forum room.

**Open Discussion:** A question was brought up as to whether any arrests were made after the vandalism at BNHS. None of the members present knew. Carla read a thank you from the Varsity softball team thanking us for the spirit wear we donated for their raffle.
