Wish List Meeting**

Called to Order: 6:59 pm at Timber Pointe

Secretary's Minutes: Jeff moved to approve the minutes from the February meeting, Rob 2nd the motion. All directors approved.

Treasurer Report: Most bills from winter concessions have been paid. The CD with the stadium funds will be due April 1, 2010 and Joan will put this money in the booster checking account because interest is so low right now. She also paid the deposit on our space at the fair. We just received a check for \$288.67 from the Buc Boosters for our share of the money left in the Castle Challenge account. Joan would like the coaches to contact her via email concerning bills for their wish list items. A motion was made to accept the treasurer's report by Sandy and Kim 2nd; all directors approved.

Athletic Director: Spencer introduced Ryan Zarembski, our new head football coach. Ryan thanked us for the sideline turf protectors we will be purchasing and said he will encourage more parent participation in booster sponsored events and fundraisers. He will also be holding a meeting April 8 for students interested in playing football for the 2010-11 season.

Merchandise: BCMS 8th grade girls' basketball team purchased shirts for the whole team to celebrate winning the championship two years in a row!

Concessions: A big thank you to Carla Sullivan for all her hard work and organization of concessions this year. She has done a terrific job!

Fundraising: Thunderbowl profit from March 12, 2010 was \$782. Thank you to all who attended! Our profit from the four bowling events this year totaled \$2,400.

Thunderfest – September 11, 2010 at Wings and Wheels Museum – Save the Date!

Vending Machines – Aramark's contract for the outside vending machines near the baseball field and track will end soon. If we want to stock them ourselves, we could make a profit on these.

Old Business: Senior Banquet – Because of recent budget cuts within District 100, Joan moved that we table this event until next year and discuss it at that time. Jeff 2nd and the motion was approved. Michelle Dixon was in charge of this committee and let us know that we could've rented the community building for \$275 and purchased the dinner from Bravos for \$500. We will keep this in mind for next year. It was brought up that Sarah Gamble still owes us money from concessions that we were going to recoup at the Senior Banquet. Joan said she would draft a letter to her asking for a financial recap and a check for the amount she owes the boosters.

Dick has a meeting tomorrow with Greg Brown regarding the wish list items. They both have a list of past purchases and want to let coaches know that they support our encouragement of team fundraising, community service and volunteer work at our concessions and fundraising events. Dick also said that future wish list items should be purchased for the entire athletic department so the A.D. can inventory them. If items are broken or stolen, they are district property. Greg also told Dick that the district should be able to take responsibility for maintaining and storing the turf sideline protectors we will be purchasing for football/soccer.

Applebee's – Jeff and Spencer will send a note to the coaches about donations for the BNHS display.

New Business: It was suggested we do a fundraiser during the cross-town game at Milt Brown Stadium next year. We can only charge \$6 for the game tickets, but we could have additional ticket sales for food and beverages.

May 19, 2010 – tentative Spring Athletic awards.

Baseball is now 3-0, softball is also doing well and we are hosting the baseball regional tournament the end of May.

April 24, 2010 – BCMS is hosting the Jack and Jill track event at Milt Brown Stadium and would like to use our concession trailer. Michel and Carla said they would coordinate this.

Elections will be held at our next meeting April 26, 2010 at Timber Pointe Golf Club. Encourage members to come to this meeting and join us as a director and officer. We will also need members on committees and someone to volunteer as membership chairman. Michel is stepping down from this position.
